Cycle 4 - Lochmaben - Millhousebridge - Williamwath Hightae - Circle Description:

Route 4 - Distance 27.21 kilometres - 178 metres of ascent / 177 metres of descent

From the **Town Hall** head north on **Queen Street** to **Townhead** and through the **Barras** to **Marjoriebanks**, continue on the **B7020** road until you cross **Kinnel Bridge** where you turn right signposted for **Millhousebridge**, once you reach the bridge cross it and take the first right where you should pass a bus shelter on your right.

Continue on this road for about 6 kilometres, passing **Applegarth Church** until the road turns sharp right – do not go straight on the road is closed, there is also a fingerpost for the **Annandale Way** at this junction.

Head south until you cross a metal bridge over the **Water of Dryfe** and after a sharp left bend turn to the right just before **Dryfesdale Gate** Farm – follow this road till it crosses the **A709** Dumfries Lockerbie Road – *watch for fast traffic at the junction.*

Go straight over the crossroads heading towards **Dalton**.

Stay on the road until the crossroads at **Dalton Hook** and turn right towards **Dalton** and follow the road across **Williamwath Bridge** over the **River Annan** to the 'T' junction with the **B7020 Road**.

Turn right and after about 2 kilometres turn right onto a minor road to Smallholm and Hightae.


Pass through **Hightae** and bear left to a crossroads of the **B7020**, go straight over and take the second road on the right after about 2 kilometres.

Follow this road which passess **Lochmaben Cemetery** and the edge of the **Golf Course** to a 'T' junction, turn right and at the bottom of the hill join the **A709** Road into Lochmaben and the end of the route.
