## Quarry development

The following notes were taken from the community meeting at Hightae Hall. The proposed development will be going to planning application committee due to the number of objections and will be heard in public in due course. For more info or to make comments please go to the council page directly:

- Quarry would be screened by the displaced soil which will be replanted with native grasses, and would also help to block noise.
- Restricted to 10-12 lorries per day (24 journeys maximum).
- A small amount of water or environmentally friendly chemical will be sprayed if there is dust during blasting/crushing.
- No trees will be felled for the quarry or road. The land owner suggested he would create a fenced walking path diversion in his field where the road corner/short verges make walking dangerous with vehicles. There are no endangered species in quarry area.
- Modern machinery should cause minimal noise pollution. They can only work between 7am 5pm. Blasting and crushing will happen rarely.
